

ITE Early Admissions Exercise 2018 (for N- and O-Level students)

**Important
point**

ITE EAE is an **aptitude-based admissions** exercise that allows you to apply and receive a conditional offer for admission to ITE courses based on your **aptitude and interest**, before taking your GCE N- or O-Level exams.

If you choose not to apply to ITE through ITE EAE, you may still do so through other admissions exercises, such as the Joint Intake Exercise (JIE) or Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE).

criteria

ITE EAE is open to:

- Students who are Singapore Citizens/Permanent Residents and registered to sit for N- or O-Levels in 2018;
- International Students currently in Government, Government-aided or Independent Schools who are registered to sit for N- or O-Level in 2018; and
- Singapore Citizens/Permanent Residents who have taken the GCE N- or O-Level examinations previously.

Your conditional offer will be automatically confirmed if you meet subject-specific Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs) for the course. If your ITE EAE offer is confirmed after the release of the 2018 GCE results, you will not be eligible to participate in the upcoming JIE or JAE.

things to do

Explore your interests and develop your strengths

- Participate in activities that are related to the careers you are interested in:
 - E.g. Enrol in relevant Elective Modules in ITE to find out more about a sector;
 - E.g. Volunteer to help out at a related organization.

Research on ITE courses you are interested in and related careers

Prepare for your application

- Prepare a 100-word write-up on why you are interested in the course, including relevant skills/activities/experiences (a guide on what to write in your application is available at ITE's website)

If shortlisted, prepare for selection by ITE

- Prepare supporting documents, e.g. portfolio of related work, evidence of relevant experiences, CCA records
